Primary responsibilities include:

- Greeting racers and checking them in using computers or tablets
- Answering basic questions or directing racers to the appropriate staff member
- Helping to maintain an organized and efficient registration area
- If desired, assisting with light pack-down duties such as organizing supplies, folding tables and chairs, and light clean-up (optional)

This role:

- Takes place **indoors or under a tent**, providing protection from the elements
- Is primarily based in one location for the duration of the shift
- Is typically performed standing, however seating can be provided for accessibility
- Includes on-site training and ongoing support from a Spartan staff member
